Dangerous incident IncNot0042025 Open cut coal Roads or other vehicle operating areas



A dozer and dump truck collided when both were reversing at an overburden dump. Nobody was injured.



Mobile plant operators should always maintain situational awareness and pay attention to the movement and proximity of other machinery.

Workers must use all available aids such as mirrors, cameras and awareness systems, particularly when reversing, and establish positive communications in accordance with documented procedures.



Note: While the majority of incidents are reported and recorded within a week of the event, some are notified outside this time period. The incidents in this report therefore have not necessarily occurred in a one-week period. All newly recorded incidents, whatever the incident date, are reviewed by the Chief Inspector and senior staff each week.
