Examiners' comments:

Overall candidates showed a sound understanding of the cable repair signatory modules, the associated standards and the role of the statutory function.

Some responses were provided based on the candidate being in role of a cable repairer (operative), not as a supervisor (responsible person). Candidates need to remember that the statutory function is considered a supervisory role and examination responses need to be provided based on the candidate already being in the statutory role.

Candidates lacked understanding of the expectations of the quality systems associated with the cable repair facility i.e. non-compliance investigation and reporting. As a minimum, non-compliance investigations should consider the possibility of other affected cable repairs/equipment and the implementation of systematic controls to prevent a re-occurrence.
