Applicant declaration of landholder notice of intention to exercise rights under a small-scale title

Use this form to confirm you have notified the landholder before finalising an application for the grant of a new mineral claim application or opal prospecting licence, or an application for the renewal of an existing mineral claim, within the White Cliffs Mineral Claims District.

Before you start

You will need to:

- **for new applications:**
 - have already lodged Form WC2A – Application for a mineral claim.
 - have already lodged Form SST3 – Application for an opal prospecting licence.
 - **for renewals:** lodge Form WC6A – Application for the renewal of a mineral claim, within 2 months before the claim is due to expire.
 - complete the landholder notification (Form WC23)
 - include a map with Form WC23 for all applications for new grants or any renewal applications **where the claim area is being reduced**.
 - retain a copy of Form WC23 (and map if required)
 - send to the landholder via registered post
 - provide the department with a copy of Form WC23 and proof that it was sent by registered post, such as a receipt with tracking number or photo of the post-stamped envelope.






