
Note: Incidents are categorised as Level 1, 2 or 3 according to the seriousness of the incident, with 3 being the most serious.

### Reportable incidents overview

Note: While all incidents are investigated, generally only level 2&3 incidents are summarised below.

Level	Incident type	Summary	Comment
2	Injury 317654793001	Underground operator's hand severely crushed by timber jack on rib bolter.	Hand in line of fire when operating timber jack.
2	Mobile equipment	LHD with loaded bucket of stone collided with a parked LHD loaded with a roll of conveyor belt.	Ongoing investigation.
2	Mobile equipment	Mini-excavator toppled over when descending an earth mound.	Investigation report and review of SWMS pending.
2	Mobile equipment	Light vehicle rolled onto side after vehicle rode up onto the haul road bund while negotiating a corner.	Investigation being conducted.
1	Mobile equipment	Grader operator drove plant into side wall of haulage ramp.	Under investigation.
2	Explosives 317654930001	Misfire - packaged presplit product found during post shot inspection.	Investigation and testing to be conducted by supplier on presplit product to determine root cause of failure.
